Transportation from Heathrow Airport to Southampton

There are 3 main ways to travel from Heathrow to Southampton:

- 1. National Express Coaches (bus)
- 2. Train
- 3. Taxi

National Express Coaches (from Heathrow to Southampton)

Frequency: Every 1-2 hours **Journey Time**: A little over 2 hours **Fare**: Single £17-18 (\$26 - \$28), Return £27-28 (\$40 - \$42)

Things to Know:

- At Heathrow and Gatwick airports, it usually takes about 45 to 75 minutes to get through customs and baggage reclaim.
- On busy cruise days from Southampton when up to 4 ships may disembark at the same time, the buses may be sold out well in advance. We recommend you buy your tickets as soon as you know your travel details.
- You can use your ticket on later schedules if your flight is late and you miss the bus as a result. This is subject to seat availability on the following bus.
- Your ticket guarantees you a seat, but does not reserve any particular place, so you can sit on any vacant seat when you board the coach.
- The luggage allowance: two cases per person in the hold, neither of which should weigh more than 20kg (44 lbs). In the cabin, you can take a small item of luggage like a handbag or laptop that you can put under a seat or keep on your lap.
- IMPORTANT: When you book National Express online, select Southampton Coach Station as your destination. The coaches leave from terminals 1, 3, 4, and 5.
- Upon arrival at the Southampton Coach Station, you are within walking distance to both the Grand Harbour Hotel (about 10-12 minutes) and the Port of Southampton (about 20-25 minutes). However, depending upon luggage and time constraints, you might prefer to take a taxi.

Trains to Southampton

From Heathrow Airport: When purchasing tickets online, please select FROM "Heathrow Rail [All Stations]" and TO "Southampton Central [SOU]." Pay attention to which terminal your train is leaving from; it will be more convenient to match it to the terminal that your plane arrives into.

Frequency: Around every half hour from various terminals **Journey time**: 2 – 2.5 hours **Fare**: Single £30 - £70 (\$45 - \$106), Return £45 - £90 (\$68 - \$136)

If you are traveling from Gatwick Airport: When purchasing tickets online, please select FROM "Gatwick Airport [GTW]" and TO "Southampton Central [SOU]." Frequency: Around every half hour Journey time: 1.5 – 2 hours Fare: Single £10 - £33 (\$15 - \$50), Return £25 - £70 (\$38 - \$106) <u>If you are already in London</u>: Trains leave regularly for Southampton from Waterloo Station in London (every 15-30 minutes). When purchasing tickets online, please select FROM "London Waterloo [WAT] and TO "Southampton Central [SOU]."

Things to know:

- At Heathrow and Gatwick airports, it usually takes about 45 to 75 minutes to get through customs and baggage reclaim.
- Customers may take up to 3 items of personal luggage free of charge; this includes two large items (such as suitcases or backpacks) and one item of smaller hand luggage (such as a briefcase).
- ➤ Upon arrival at Southampton Central Railway Station, you are within walking distance of the Grand Harbour hotel (10 12 minutes) or if you prefer, taxis are available at the station. If heading straight to the port, we recommend you take a taxi.
