**Brief Overview:** Italy is a feast for the eyes and the palate alike. Known for its style, picturesque scenery, food, art and culture, Italy offers something for everyone. Civitavecchia is located just over an hour from Rome's city center by bus or train and provides easy access to many of Italy's wonders. Naples is in southern Italy and provides easy access to Pompeii, Mount Vesuvius and the Amalfi Coast. For a rich experience, it will be important to find a balance between the well-known cities and the lesser-known towns and scenic countryside.

**Nearby:** Enjoy the **Etruscan Necropolis of Monterozzi in Tarquinia**; visit the Renaissance **Villa Lante** and the **Sacred Wood of Bomarzo**; and experience the flavors of Italy with **cooking classes** and tastings.

**Worth the drive:** Discover the town of **Orvieto**, with its curious underground city and famous **Duomo**. **Rome** and the **Vatican** are not to be missed and there are a wide range of options to see them including: **CIV 201-301 Rome, the Eternal City**; and **CIV 101 101 Highlights of Rome**.



Other worthwhile destinations include the beautiful villages of **Cinqueterre** with their colorful houses (**CIV 302-201 Cinqueterre – The Land of Poets**); the ancient Roman city of **Pompeii**; the coastal town of **Sorrento**, and Tuscany's city of art – **Florence (CIV 303-201: Italian Arts Tour)**.

Here is your opportunity to see all of the most famous Italian Cities: Venice; Verona; Florence; Rome and Naples. In addition, you will explore the fascinating ruins of Pompeii.

In Venice, enjoy a boat ride and a visit to Muran, Burano and Torcello, the three most famous islands of the Venetian lagoon. There is free time to explore

and have lunch before an afternoon walking tour to see St Mark's Square, the Doge's Palace (exterior only), and St Mark's Basilica. After dinner at a local restaurant, take a relaxing gondola ride.

On the way to Florence, there will be a stop in Verona to see Romeo and Juliet's famous balcony followed by free time for lunch. Upon arrival in Florence enjoy time to relax before a stroll to the restaurant for dinner. The next day, experience Florence with a walking tour featuring the Duomo of St. Mary's, Signoria Square, the Old Bridge and Holy Cross Church. You will then enter the Academy of Arts to see the beautiful statue of David. Following free time for lunch and exploration head off to Rome.

After dinner at Meo Patacca restaurant in Teastevere, enjoy a Rome by night tour including Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon and Navona Square. A full day tour of Rome awaits beginning with the Colosseum and Roman forum. After an early lunch visit the Vatican Museums and St Peter's Basilica. The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure. On your final day visit the excavations of Pompeii followed by lunch. Next, head to Naples for an orientation tour before rejoining the ship.

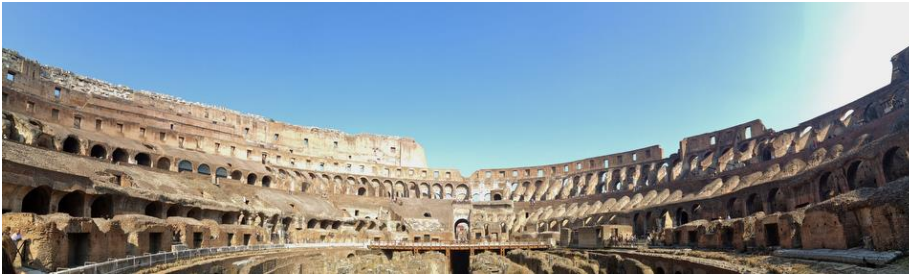

Next, walk into the mother of all Catholic churches - **St. Peter's Basilica**. Enjoy some time to reflect on the morning experiences over lunch at a local restaurant where you will taste the specialties of Italian cuisine. After lunch, visit the symbol of the Eternal City, the **Colosseum** passing by the main monuments of the city such as the **Roman Forum**, where the city of Rome was founded.

2DAYS/1NIGHT



Pasta means culture. Pasta means tradition. Here is your opportunity to experience the beautiful Tuscan countryside and its cuisine including the chance to make your own pasta al mattarello.

Begin with a visit to Antica Fattoria La Parrina - this farmhouse cultivates 65 hectares of vineyards of both red and white grape types. The climate, characterized by sea winds, hot summers and rainy autumns, is ideal for the ripening of the fruit until harvest time. You will visit the various sections of the farm, including the wine cellar to learn about the traditional bottling methods still used today. Next, enjoy lunch featuring local

products. After lunch there is time to soak up the relaxing atmosphere of the

farm, to take pictures or shop if you wish. In the afternoon drive through the Maremma plain to reach Scansano country hotel, your home for tonight and tomorrow.

You may have already heard of home madetagliatelle, *gnocchi*, *tortelli* and *pappardelle* - but do you know what '**mattarello**' means?? Today you learn to make your own *pasta al mattarello* and you'll be proud of it! After the cooking lesson, you'll be ready for lunch at the farm, including a glass of red wine typical of Maremma plain. Enjoy the afternoon at your leisure, perhaps relaxing at the pool, before your return drive to Civitavecchia.

The 5 villages of Cinqueterre, located on a stretch of rugged coastline on the Italian Riviera, have been left almost untouched by modern development making it the most beautiful coastline you're likely to find in Europe.

Your first stop is Pisa with the famous Leaning Tower where you will have a guided tour as well as some free time for exploration and lunch on your own. After lunch, proceed to Portovenere a UNESCO World Heritage site with its picturesque harbor, brightly colored houses, and narrow medieval streets lined with shops. After check in at the hostel, enjoy the rest of the afternoon and evening at your leisure.

On your second day, you will travel by boat to explore the small villages of Riomaggiore, Vernazza and Monterosso with the option to return with the guide to Portovenere or linger in Monterosso and return on your own using the boat ticket provided by your guide.

On the last day, you will hike through the wilds of Palmaria Island finding the ruins of prisons, quarries and fortresses hidden among the Mediterranean trees.

Explore the Tuscan art capital of Florence and discover the historical background of some major Italian artists. Depart from the port city and reach Florence in the early afternoon. Check in at the hotel and enjoy a guided walking tour to familiarize you with the city! Visit the main highlights of the so-called “cradle of

Renaissance” such as the Brunelleschi **dome** crowning the Cathedral, **Signoria square** and the **Old Bridge**, Ponte Vecchio, the oldest bridge crossing the Arno River. You will have a reserved-time, guided tour of the **Accademia of Fine Arts** to admire the original statue of David among other works of art and a visit to the **Basilica di Santa Croce**. Dinner is

included on your first day to introduce you to local culture and traditions.



The next day, you will visit other Florentine highlights allowing you to deepen your knowledge Michelangelo. Visit the Church of the Holy Spirit, Casa Buonarroti (**Michelangelo's birthplace**) and Palazzo Vecchio, hosting the **Genio della Vittoria** by Michelangelo. The afternoon and evening is free to explore on your own.

Your last day takes you along the Tyrrhenian coastline to Pisa where you will visit Miracles Square and the monuments contained. After the short introduction tour, time at leisure

for your independent exploration and lunch. In the afternoon resume the drive to Civitavecchia and board the ship

Enjoy a pleasant walk and visit some of the most famous sights of Rome! After a **brief panoramic drive** featuring the Colosseum, you will reach the city center of Rome where you will start your walk passing by the celebrated **Spanish Steps** with its curious "Barcaccia" fountain by Bernini's father. You will continue down Via del Tritone leading to the world famous **Trevi Fountain (Under Restoration)** (toss a coin to ensure your return to Rome!). From there a short walk

will take you to **Via del Corso**; later you will see the **Pantheon** and finally you will reach one of the most marvellous squares in the world, **Navona Square**, where you will enjoy a delicious pizza lunch at a local restaurant. Later you will board the coach and proceed to the magnificent **St. Peter's Basilica**, with its splendid Bernini's square surrounded by marble columns and the statues of Saints and Popes. At the end of the guided tour you will have a little free time before returning to Civitavecchia. Don't spend your precious time waiting in line! A strict dress code is enforced in St. Peter's Basilica. Short pants, miniskirts, tank tops and revealing clothing are not acceptable and guests wearing these items can be restricted from entering.

Visit the ruins of the important Etruscan City of Vulci on this excursion to the Vulci Naturalistic-Archaeological Park. This ancient city is surrounded by natural wonders allowing visitors to explore the site's history, archaeology, tradition and culture

all in a flourishing garden. Your tour includes a visit to the **Pellicone Lake** where you will have free time for lunch.

Later you will drive to Tarquinia to visit the Etruscan Necropolis of Monterozzi, where it is still possible to admire the famous painted tombs. The paintings on the walls of the tombs are really amazing and the colors mixed from iron oxide, lapis lazuli, dust and charcoal are incredibly vivid. After this interesting stop you will resume the drive to Civitavecchia.

ROME THE ETERNAL CITY

2DAYS/1NIGHT



Two full days to discover Rome by day and night, when the majority of tourists have left the city. Depart Civitavecchia for Rome (1.5 hours), learning about its history and surroundings on the way. Upon arrival in the Eternal City, enjoy an Orientation tour of the archaeological district and the major basilicas, including time

for a late morning snack. After hotel check-in, head to the Vatican for a reserved-time visit to the fascinating **Vatican Museums** and the **Sistine Chapel** by Michelangelo, before stepping into the largest Catholic church in the world: **St. Peter's Basilica**. The Vatican tour ends at 3.30pm, with the rest of the afternoon to explore Rome at leisure. In the evening, enjoy a tour by night including dinner in a typical Roman restaurant. The drive by night is the best way to admire the monuments of the Eternal city.

Your second day in Rome will be dedicated to familiarize with the Roman Empire! Check out and leave the hotel by tour bus. Set off with your tour guide to reach the **Circus maximus**, the **Caracalla Baths** and the **Palatine Hill** seen from the top of the Aventine Hill. Continue then on to the **Colosseum** and visit this enormous amphitheatre which became the symbol of the Eternal city. Visit also the **Roman Forum** – the center of political, economic and social life at the time of ancient Rome. After the guided tour, free time for lunch and some more exploration on your own before your return to the ship.

This overnight program provides the opportunity to see the Eternal City of **Rome**, the ruins of **Pompeii**, and the beautiful southern coastal area including **Sorrento** and **Capri**.

Begin your adventure in Rome with the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Square. After some free time for lunch in the Vatican area, freshen up at your hotel before dinner and a Rome-by-night tour.

The next day, head to Pompeii for a guided tour of the excavations. Explore this well preserved ancient Roman city and learn about Roman culture and Pompeii's inhabitants buried by the Vesuvius ashes during the eruption of 79 a.d. Lunch is included at a local restaurant before resuming the drive to Sorrento. Enjoy the evening at your leisure exploring this seaside town.

The next morning, wake up in Sorrento and set off to discover the **island of Capri!** Enjoy a full-day tour with free time for lunch and soak in the charming atmosphere of this most cherished Italian island! Return to Sorrento for a group dinner after some time for relaxation.

On your final day you will have an early check-out and depart to Naples for a panoramic tour of the city. See Mount Vesuvius in the background as you stop at the hill of Posillipo in the residential area of the city, boasting the most exciting views of the city and the gulf of Naples with its three islands of Ischia, Procida and Capri. Continue towards the historical center of Naples traveling along the sea front road Via Caracciolo, through the district of Santa Lucia and then on to the famous Piazza Plebiscito to admire the Royal palace, the san Carlo Opera house, galleria Umberto I and the beautiful Piazza Municipio, where the imposing Castel Nuovo is found. After some time for lunch on your own, return to the ship.

**Please Note:** This program is **not** recommended for wheelchair-bound people. No elevator in the minibuses; very steep streets and alleys on the island and the archaeological site is entirely uneven, sometimes steep.

Go back in time to the medieval village of Tuscania and spend the evening in a castle.

Proceno was built on the peak of a dormant volcano and is surrounded by woods and green valleys, scattered with ruins of past civilizations. The Castello di Proceno is a rare example of a medieval fortification surviving in its original state located on Cassia road, a leading ancient route for commerce, culture and religious pilgrimages.

Begin with a drive through the region called Tuscia to the perfectly preserved medieval village – Tuscania. Guided tour of Tuscania upon arrival followed by a stop at the Lake of Bolsena, a crater lake of volcanic origin. In the afternoon, resume the drive to Proceno Castle, where the owner will take us on a tour of the Medieval village including the Museum of the farming tradition in a beautiful ancient Palace. Next, enjoy dinner and overnight in the castle.

The next day, travel on the Via Francigena, for years the most important route between northern and southern Europe. Monuments, splendid cathedrals, villas and magnificent gardens enriched the cities along the journey and this route is often considered the birthplace of European unity. In 1994, the Council of Europe recognized it as a “European Cultural Itinerary.” You will visit an important Basilica on the road to Christian Rome, Bolsena, famous for the Miracle of the Eucharist in the Santa Cristina Basilica.

This trip to southern Tuscany allows you to visit 2 nature reserves, relax and swim at the beach as well as see Capalbio village.

The Orbetello Nature Reserve and Lagoon is partially managed by WWF Italy whose goal is to stop environmental destruction and build a future where humans live in harmony with nature. It is located along one of Europe's main migration routes and is considered one of the most important wetlands providing vital rest and breeding site for many species of birds. The Reserve boasts variety of rare cork oak trees and bushes, sand dunes and 300 hectares of salty lagoon. The Orbetello lagoon is most famous for its bird population with around 300 species of birds visiting every year including flamingoes, common stilts, great egrets, grey herons, ospreys, northern shovelers, Eurasian spoonbills and pied avocets. In the afternoon, travel to the hostel which is walking distance from the beach. After free time for relaxation enjoy a group dinner at the hostel, an 18<sup>th</sup> century farm.

The Repubblica dei Ragazzi, originally operated by Father Marcello Bolzonello, provides shelter and education for boys, ages 9 to 18 years, who have social, economic and family problems. The facility is comparable to the original “Boys

Town” started by Father Flannagan in 1917; the U.S. story gained international attention when it was brought to the silver screen in 1938 with Spencer Tracy starring as the Oscar-winning priest. Nobody obliges them to stay; the gate is always open. Everybody at the home has a

different “duty” such as assisting with housework, health or finances. Each week the duties change. The youth are self-governed and elect a “mayor” monthly. On average there are 30 teenagers at the facility and approximately 20 tutors. The children go to the various schools in town studying subjects such as tourism, accounting, and other topics to prepare for high school. Visit with the priest to learn more about this unique facility and have an opportunity to interact with the students before returning to the ship.

divide the city into two nearly equal parts. You will see the large Jesuit church of *Gesù Nuovo* with its famous diamond point facade, the gothic church of *Santa Chiara* built for the order of Robert Anjou in 1310.

Walk along until you arrive at *San Domenico* square, heart of the Decumano adorned by its “guglia” (spire). Here enjoy some free time to browse around or take a nice Neapolitan coffee or cappuccino. After the pleasant walk through the old center, the tour will continue to the inner city, into the real “basso

*napolentano*”.

Here in the “basso” you will be treated to “The Aperitivo Tarantella”, entertainment where the tarantella is sung and played live involving everyone in a liberating dance, and all of this enriched by a large buffet. The entertainer is a master of Neapolitan commedia dell’arte with a thousand faces such as the one of Pulcinella. After a fantastic experience in the Neapolitan alleyways, head back to the ship.
