

SEMESTER AT SEA® The Institute for Shipboard Education Lifelong Learning Student Assistant Grant Instructions and Application

*Note: Student Assistants traditionally board the ship one day prior to ship embarkation. Applicants should wait to make flight arrangements until after the award date.

This application is for students interested in a position as an assistant to the Lifelong Learning Coordinator aboard the *MV World Odyssey*. Students receiving this grant will be expected to work 2 hours every day while at sea. There will be no work expectations while in port. Students will also be expected to arrive one day before embarkation to assist the faculty and staff with prevoyage preparation and student check-in. Student Assistants hold an esteemed position within the shipboard community since they will have a special relationship with the faculty and staff onboard. With this award comes increased presence and responsibilities. As a result, recipients are expected to hold themselves to the highest standards when it comes to work performance and personal demeanor.

The Lifelong Learning Program Coordinator and Student Assistant are directly responsible for creating a cohesive community of Lifelong Learners (LLL) that is integrated into the shipboard community by:

• Encouraging LLLs to participate in ship activities, to include: Staff/LLL talent show; post-port open mike; pre-port skits; Extended Family program; Bridge Club; Exercise Club; Sea Olympics; presentation for Explorer Seminar; hosting sea social for extended families.

Students are expected to perform work duties as assigned by the LLL Coordinator. Any student failing to perform duties as assigned may be removed from the position and required to reimburse ISE for hours not worked. <u>Students may only apply for one student assistant position.</u>

To be considered for the Lifelong Learning student assistant position, please submit the following:

- Application (attached)
- Résumé
- Cover letter
- Letter of Reference
- 300-500 word essay on the following topic: *What leadership qualities do you bring to the Lifelong Learning position?*

Applications must arrive in the ISE office by the due date listed for your voyage on the Semester at Sea web site. Faxed applications will not be accepted.
