



SEMESTER AT SEA NEED-BASED GRANTS AND MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

NEED- BASED GRANTS

Colorado State University students who participate on Semester at Sea may be eligible for need-based grants which are deducted from the student’s final invoice. Grant awards are first-come, first until funding has been fully allocated. \$150,000 in grant funding is available each fall and spring semester.

Grants are awarded based on a student’s Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated through their CSU institutional aid application.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THESE CSU/SAS NEED-BASED GRANTS, STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

1. Be a current CSU student
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid at fafsa.ed.gov
3. Complete the CSU Institutional Aid Application available via Ram-Web
4. Register via CSU Education Abroad for the Semester at Sea program
5. Apply and have been admitted to Semester at Sea

MERIT- BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Colorado State University students who have a minimum 3.0 GPA are eligible for a merit-based scholarship. Students may not have received the need-based CSU-administered Semester at Sea grant.

Maximum awards of \$5,000 each fall and spring are available. The merit-based scholarship is managed by the CSU Education Abroad Office. The deadlines to apply are April 15 for the fall semester and October 15 for the spring semester.
